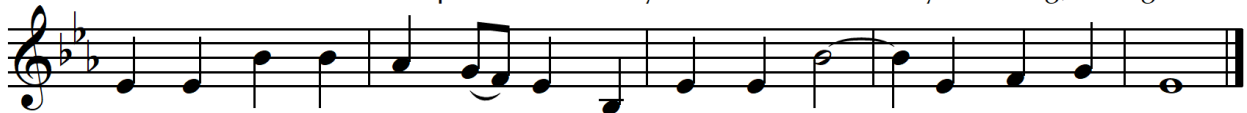

Amen!

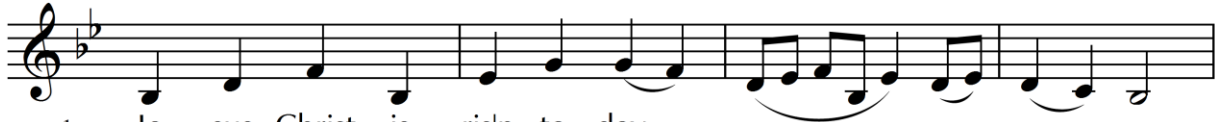
