



Guide to Mass at Saint Bonaventure During Phase II

Saint Bonaventure has formulated a plan to re-open for public Mass aligned with the "Phase II" guidelines given by the Archdiocese of Saint Paul & Minneapolis. Our Mass schedule will resume June 4. Here is our guide for Mass during this time.

We prayerfully request your patience. Please know we are doing what we can to offer a meaningful worship experience that is in alignment with the guidelines provided by the Archdiocese.

SIGN UP FOR MASS

- We will have limited capacity, so we ask you to sign up for only one Mass per week.
- Sign up for Mass at saintbonaventure.org, or call 952-854-4733 each week.
- If you are able to attend a weekday Mass, we ask you to consider that, thus allowing space for someone who may not have that flexibility.




OBLIGATION SUSPENDED

- The obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation continues to be suspended as long as the pandemic continues.
- All COVID-19 positive individuals, those with symptoms, and those living with them must stay home.
- Individuals in the high-risk category and over 65 are encouraged to stay home during Phase II.



ENTERING THE CHURCH

- The North and South entrances will open 30 minutes before Mass.
- If a line starts to form, please maintain social distance.
- Welcoming Attendants will greet you and show you an available seat to maximize our limited capacity.



LIVESTREAM LITURGIES

- Saint Bonaventure will continue to record and share Mass on our website: saintbonaventure.org/stayingconnected
- We are working towards offering a livestream of Mass and will let you know when we are ready to go!



MASK & SANITIZE

- Please wear a mask while in the church and only remove your mask to receive the Eucharist.
- Carry a tissue or hanky to cover a cough or sneeze.
- Please bring your own or use provided hand sanitizer.
- Consider using the restroom at home before coming to church if possible.



WORSHIP GUIDES

- A guide for worship will be available for you to pick up as you enter the church.
- For sanitary purposes, we will not be reusing these so please take your copy home with you after Mass.
- Hymnals have been removed from the worship space.
- Bulletins will also be available for you to take home.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Each individual must remain 6 feet away from others outside your own household.
- Please resist the urge to gather on church grounds before or after Mass.
- Pews will be marked accordingly for seating.
- The floor will be marked to help establish distance for the distribution of Holy Communion.



HOLY COMMUNION

- Holy Communion will take place after Mass, and individuals will be invited to receive the Eucharist on their way out of the church.
- The Eucharist will be given in-hand. If the Eucharist must be given on the tongue (due to medical necessity) then a family member will receive the Eucharist by-hand and will give the Eucharist onto that person's tongue.



LITURGY MODIFICATIONS

- Congregational singing will be temporarily suspended.
- Refrain from holding hands during the Lord's Prayer.
- Only offer a Sign of Peace that does not involve touching; we suggest a nod or a friendly wave.



COLLECTION

- We are grateful for your gifts.
- Tables with collection baskets will be at the entrances to the church for your convenience.

Mass Schedule at Saint Bonaventure During Phase II

We will adhere to this schedule for three weeks upon resuming public Mass.

Daily Mass

Tuesday - Friday: 8:45 a.m. in the church

Weekend Mass

Saturday: 4:30 p.m. in the church (recorded and potentially live-streamed)

Sunday: 8 a.m. in the church

10 a.m. Mass on the Grass (weather permitting)

We will have limited capacity inside the church:

- You will be asked to call or sign up online to attend.
- Please sign up for only one Mass a week.
- If you are able to attend a weekday Mass, we ask you to consider doing that, thus allowing space for someone who may not have that flexibility.
- If you are over 65 and choose to join us for Mass, we encourage you to join us for Mass on the Grass.

For Mass on the Grass:

- Mass will take place on the field behind the Activities Building.
- Bring your own chair or blanket to seat yourself.
- In the case of inclement weather, this Mass will be cancelled for that day. Please tune into the recorded Mass for that Sunday.
- Feel free to bring water, a hat, umbrella and sunblock!

Sacraments of Healing: Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick

Parishioners are welcomed to celebrate these Sacraments by appointment. Please call the parish office, 952-854-4733.
