Homily

As a reminder for communion today, please remember we will receive the Body of Christ at the end of Mass on our way out. Father will receive communion at the altar, then finish the final prayer and blessing. When he lifts the host up and says "The Body of Christ," you will respond "Amen" at that time rather than when facing the Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC). The Welcoming Attendants will indicate when you may leave your pew; please take everything with you. The EMHCs will be at the exits. As you approach them, please remove your mask, then when they hold up the host, you should nod and put your hands out. Consume the Body of Christ immediately, then continue to your car. Say a prayer in your car or on your walk home, knowing the presence of Christ.

New Contribution Envelope Company

Those of you who receive contribution envelopes in the mail will be receiving your envelopes as usual in the next few weeks. We heard your feedback! And you will notice a change in your bi-monthly packet as we have switched envelope vendors to Our Sunday Visitor (OSV) of Huntington, Indiana. In April, our previous envelope provider discontinued contribution envelopes that could be placed directly in the mail, and many reached out and indicated a strong preference for envelopes that can be mailed. OSV offered contribution envelopes that fit our needs and had comparable pricing.

Back-to-School Supply Drive—July 19 - August 2



Next Step Program Report

The Next Step Program was established as an official part of the St. Vincent de Paul Society in the fall of 2018 after much discussion and a vote by its members and then followed by a generous grant from the parish. The program's mission is to aggressively pursue helping people who are in poverty become financially independent. Program members are motivated by the fact that all classes of society now realize that communities are not sustainable if any group is disenfranchised for any reason. The key to alleviating poverty of cities and people is neighborhood regeneration that maximizes the synergistic effects of local collaboration. Deprivation and powerlessness of the poor wounds the whole community.

The Next Step Program identifies people who are in poverty and, with our help, are determined to become financially independent. We have 6 coaches who are trained to assist such people and currently four of them are meeting with four individuals as part of this program. We are happy to report that some definite progress has been made.
